Please accept our sincere thanks for the gift of \$1,339.73. With a staff of ten and several hundred volunteers, ICDI accompanies immigrants from the time they are incarcerated until they are either deported or their case is resolved, and they are settling down in the United States. Your gifts to us this year have enabled us to help hundreds of individuals and families.

The COVID pandemic has changed the work, but the work continues. Visits in the jails are now made virtually (*sadly, these video calls are not free*), as are the visits to the detention centers holding children. Staff, not volunteers, are meeting people when they are released from jail.

ICDI has been distributing funds for direct relief from the COVID pandemic, assisting individuals and families in Illinois and the surrounding states. Many asylees work entry level jobs in the hospitality industry and the hotels and restaurants laid them off back in April of 2020, so the need is great.

Know that your gift will go a long way to keeping a roof over someone's head, keep the A/C and heat on, and keep food on the table this fall season.
